NOTE :-

THE CHECKLIST IS TO BE COMPLETED BY THE CHIEF OFFICER AND DULY SIGNED BY ALL. SAME TO BE GIVEN TO MASTER PRIOR DEPARTURE EVERY PORT. LOG ENTRY OF SEARCH TO BE MADE IN THE DECK LOG BOOK.

CHIEF ENGINEER IS INCHARGE FOR ENGINE ROOM SEARCH. CHIEF OFFICER TO BE INFORMED AND CHECK LIST TO BE SIGNED PRIOR DEP.

ALL DEPARTMENT HEADS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR STORES INSIDE & OUTSIDE ACCOMODATION.

ALL CREW AND OFFICERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CABINS.

CHIEF COOK IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CATERING STORES , REF ROOMS & GALLEY.

NOT WITHSTANDING THE ABOVE, THE MASTER OR THE SHIP SECURITY OFFICER MAY DESIGNATE ANY PERSON TO CARRY OUT A SEARCH OF ANY CABIN OR AREA.

ALL RESTRICTED AREAS AND STORES CHECKED SHOULD BE KEPT LOCKED.

ALL SPARE CABINS AND OTHER UNUSED ROOMS SHOULD BE KEPT LOCKED AND SECURED AT ALL TIMES. AN EASILY VISIBLE TELL-TALE SEAL SHOULD BE AFFIXED TO THE DOORS, PORT-HOLES, KICK-OUT PANELS, ETC., SO THAT IT WILL BE READILY APPARENT IF ANY UNAUTHORISED ENTRY HAS BEEN MADE INTO SUCH CABINS OR ROOMS. NOTWITHSTANDING THESE CABINS AND ROOMS ARE KEPT LOCKED AND SEALED, THEY SHOULD STILL BE INCLUDED IN STOWAWAY AND CONTRABAND SEARCHES, AND RE-LOCKED AND RE-SEALED AFTER SEARCH."

SPECIAL ATTENTION SHOULD BE PAID TO THOROUGH SEARCHES OF ANY CABINS OR SPACES USED BY ANY SHORE PERSONNEL IN PORT, INCLUDING THOSE USED BY SHORE WATCHMEN OR SECURITY GUARDS.

INFREQUENTLY USED PLACES SUCH AS PIPE DUCTS AND VENTILATOR DUCTS IN THE FALSE CEILING, LIFEBOATS, ETC., MAY BE SEALED WITH A PAPER STICKER AFTER A THOROUGH SEARCH TO INDICATE IT HAS NOT BEEN OPENED.

THOUGH NOT ALL-INCLUSIVE, THE FOLLOWING MAY BE PROBABLE AREAS WHERE CONTRABAND GOODS MAY BE HIDDEN.

CABINS

- Back sides and underneath drawers
- Between bottom drawer and deck
- Beneath bunks, i.e., taped to bunk frame under mattress or in hollow space under false bottom / bunk board.
- Under wash basin
- Inside radios, recorders etc
- Ventilator ducts
- Above or behind light fixtures
- Above ceiling and wall panels
- Cut-outs behind bulkheads, pictures, etc.
- False bottom clothes closets-hanging clothes

- Inside wooden clothes hangers
- Inside rolled socks, spare socks
- Hollowed-out molding

COMPANIONWAYS

- Ducts
- Wire harnesses
- Railings
- Fire extinguishers
- Access panels in floors, walls, ceilings
- Behind or inside water coolers

TOILET AND SHOWERS

- Behind and under washbasins
- Behind toilets
- In ventilation ducts and heaters
- Toilet tissue rollers, towel dispensers
- Taped to shower curtains, exposed piping, and light fixtures
- Access panels in floors, walls, ceiling

DECK

- Ledges on deck housing, electrical switch rooms, winch control panels
- Lifeboat storage compartments, under coiled rope, in deck storage rooms
- Paint cans, cargo holds, battery rooms, chain lockers.

ENGINE ROOM

- Under deck plates
- Cofferdams, machinery pedestals, bilges
- Journal-bearing shrouds and sumps on propeller shaft
- Under catwalk, in bilges, in shaft alley
- Escape ladders and ascending area.
- In ventilation ducts, attached to piping or in tanks with false gauges.
- Equipment boxes, emergency steering rooms, storage spaces.
- Rudder Trunking

GALLEYS AND STEWARDS' STORES

- Flour bins and dry stores
- Vegetable sacks, canned foods (re-glued labels)
- Under or behind standard refrigerators
- Inside fish or sides of beef in freezers
- Bonded store lockers, slop chest, storage rooms.
