GENERAL EMERGENCY ALARM: 7 or more short blasts followed by a prolonged blast.

FIRE ALARM: Alarm activated through Fire detection system or manually
(INTERRUPTED / CONTINUOUS RINGING OF ALARM BELLS)
+ followed by the General Emergency station signal.

ABANDON SHIP: VERBAL ORDER ONLY, GIVEN BY MASTER.

NOTE: The above signals may be given on the General Alarm or ship's whistle or both. Vessel's Public Address system will also be used. Dial '0' on telephone and shout 'FIRE' and location. For all Emergencies you will be assisted by a steward or someone from the ship's company.

Your Lifeboat is: 'B' deck Aft (Free fall)

Your Lifeboat duties are: IMMEDIATE ACTION: DON YOUR LIFE JACKET, WEAR WARM CLOTHES AND PROCEED IMMEDIATELY TO YOUR MUSTER STATION ASSISTED BY STEWARD.

Your Emergency Station is on: THE BRIDGE.

Your Emergency Duties are: IMMEDIATE ACTION: TAKE YOUR LIFEJACKET, WEAR WARM CLOTHING AND PROCEED IMMEDIATELY TO THE BRIDGE. GUIDED BY THE STEWARD.

The nearest fire extinguisher to your cabin is of type: DCP **Location:** Alleyway

The nearest fire box to your cabin is located: Outside accommodation(P&S)

The nearest Manual Fire Alarm call point to your cabin is located: Near staircase

Nearest Emergency escape from your cabin is: External doors(P&S)

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GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Do not throw any garbage overboard. Everything to be disposed only in the bins provided in the cabin. There is a separate bin for disposal of plastics.
2. In case of Blackout or a power failure, please use the Flashlight provided and be calm. Emergency lighting would come on by itself and somebody would come to assist.
3. Do not dispose anything in the W.C. except toilet paper.
4. You would be informed in advance when vessel expects heavy weather. Please secure all loose personal effects to avoid any personal injury or damage to any equipment.
5. There are Luminous / Glow in dark tapes stuck outside your cabin and in the alleyways which lead you to the exit doors.
6. At night or dark hours, you are requested to pull down blinds and curtains in your Cabin and Passenger Reception Hall as the light from the portholes hampers navigation.
7. Cargo working area, Galley, Engine Room and Navigation Bridge are out of bounds for passengers without Master's authorization.
8. Smoking in bed is Strictly Prohibited as it is a major fire hazard.
9. No deck / dirty shoes allowed inside accommodation.
10. In port, please ensure that all accommodation exit doors are re - locked after use.
11. Passengers should not carry parcels of any sort without knowing its contents - for Anti-drug drive.
12. FYI, you are liable for search and identification checks. Please carry visitors pass, cabin keys and photo ID for checks at authorized boarding points.
13. Please do not enter areas which are marked as restricted areas.
14. In case of any assistance / emergency, contact Bridge Tel. No. **_20** Or Captain's cabin Tel. No. **_23**

NOTE: This familiarization **MUST** be given to every joining passenger.
