The result of research indicates, factors causing the delay of discharging is less of skill by operator container crane in the operation of unloading containers and also less of discipline of the duty officer, foreman, and labor inspector during the process of unloading the container. Efforts are made to prevent delays in the discharge of containers by increasing the crane capability of operators, increasing discipline while carrying out the duty office during the process of discharging, and improving coordination between ships and foreman or laborers.

From the results of the study it can be concluded that the delay of discharging the container on board the MV. Meratus Balikpapan 1 is a less of discipline supervision of duty officers, foreman, laborers and less of skill of operator container crane.
